

<u>Hours of Adoration:</u> The Altar of Repose will be in the convent classroom. Please sign up in the church vestibule for hours of adoration on Holy Thursday and Good Friday. We must have two people for each hour to adore the Most Blessed Sacrament. We particularly need adorers throughout the night of Holy Thursday.

<u>Indulgences:</u> The faithful who devoutly visit the Blessed Sacrament in the Altar of Repose on Holy Thursday or Good Friday, and recite the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be five times in order to return due thanks for the institution of the Holy Eucharist, and one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be for the intentions of the Church, are granted an indulgence of 15 years or a Plenary indulgence on each day, if in addition to confession, they receive Our Lord in Holy Communion on Holy Thursday. <u>Altar Boys' Lunch:</u> After Mass on Holy Saturday all servers are invited to lunch at the seminary.
